JOB GOAL: The mission of the Title One program is to improve the educational opportunities of students, in the areas of literacy and mathematics, by helping them:

1. Succeed in the regular program
2. Attain grade level proficiency
3. Improve achievement in basic and more advanced skills

The Title One program is committed to the belief that all students can develop and be successful in the areas of literacy and mathematics. Further, it holds that neither is there only one way to teach all students, nor do all students take the same amount of time to learn.

### PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Implement a variety of assessment instruments to determine eligibility and instructional needs of students in reading and mathematics.
2. Provide increased instructional time for selected students. This instruction may take place in both in-class and pullout models. Maintains curricular coherence at all times. Individualized academic work is the focus.
3. Demonstrate knowledge of and ability to use research-based principles of effective instruction.
4. Is a resource to teachers, as well as, work cooperatively with instructional team members, including classroom teachers, special education staff, paraprofessionals, and other Title One staff, to supply intervention to individual and small groups of students in reading and mathematics.
5. Identify instructional needs of students and monitor achievement in reading and math through the process of observation, testing, and weekly or bi-weekly progress monitoring.

6. The teacher will interpret, as appropriate, test results and statistical data concerning reading and math to teachers, principals, and parents.
7. Provide accurate documentation of student progress, maintain appropriate records of student performance and communicate progress. Provide assistance in the RTI process.
8. Demonstrate instructional leadership in the areas of literacy and mathematics by providing information to instructional team members about best practices, in the areas of reading and mathematics.
9. Plan activities for Title One parent involvement in the school.
10. Coordinate and develop with Title One Director, the Title One program in the school based on the guidelines established by the District, as well as, state and federal governments.
11. Perform such other duties as assigned or requested by building principal and/or the Title One Director.
12. Participates in faculty committees and the sponsorship of student activities.
13. Serves as a positive role model for students.
