Qualification:

- Valid (state) teacher license
- Previous coaching experience
- Knowledge and background (technical, tactical, managerial, interpersonal skills)
- Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable.

Job Goal:

- To carry out the aims and objectives of the academic bowl program as outlined by school administration
- To instruct student members in individual and team fundamentals, strategy and practice necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success.
- At the same time, the students shall receive instruction that will lead to the formation of moral values, pride of accomplishment, acceptable social behavior, self-discipline and self-confidence.

Expectations:

- Maintain high standards as a teacher, both in the classroom and for the academic team, while advocating the skills, mission and objectives of the District.
- Promote sportsmanship, be understanding and fair, and put integrity ahead of winning.
- Effectively communicate with players, parents, teachers, media, administrators and other groups within the community.
- Demonstrate necessary organizational and leadership skills
- Facilitate the practices necessary in order for the team to experience a level of success
- Facilitate the organization of the bowl event for the school team (communication from the state organization, registration, team shirts, transportation, celebrations, etc...)
- Other duties assigned by the principal
