- ▶ Focus on students academic health and social emotional health as well as the continued focus on a safe and healthy in-person learning environment.
- ▶ Emphasizes addressing disproportionately affected student subgroups.

# Allowable Uses

- ▶ How can ESSER support afterschool programming, continued learning during summer and intersession, additional tutoring, and early learning programming in my district to address learning loss and promote youth development?
- ▶ How can ESSER help meet the increased social/emotional needs of students and staff that have increased due to COVID?
- ▶ How are we meeting the needs of special populations (low income, ELs, SWD, those in foster care, students experiencing homelessness, migrant)?
- ▶ School facility repairs and improvements to reduce transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards
- ▶ Purchasing education technology
- ▶ Any activity allowed under ESEA, IDEA, AEFLA, or Perkins.

- ▶ Evidence Based Activities to Address Learning Loss, Air Quality, and Environment
  - ▶ Class Size Reduction through Increased Staffing
  - ▶ Environmental Mitigation and HVAC Upgrades
  - ▶ After School Tutoring
  - ▶ Transportation (Mini-Bus units) to facilitate after-school tutoring
  - ▶ Interventionists for special populations (e.g., EL, transient, SES)
  - ▶ Summer School Expansion
  - ▶ Continued PPE and Sanitizing Equipment/Supplies
  - ▶ Social-Emotional Learning and Mental Health Supports
  - ▶ Professional Development for all staff on best practices

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
